WEATHER UPDATE

At today's Sussex Towns Weather Bridge conference call, coordinated through the Delaware Emergency Operations Center, the following information was provided:

- Governor Markell has declared a limited state of emergency with no driving restrictions implemented and reminds residents in flood prone areas to monitor conditions carefully. For more information visit Delaware Online http://www.delawareonline.com/.
- There is no evacuation at this time and no shelters are open; however, pre-staging is in place with the National Guard.
- No significant damage has been reported some debris on roadways is in the stages of removal.
- Sussex County, particularly the coastal area, will continue on flood and potential high wind alert.
- The National Weather Service continues a coastal flood warning through Sunday. The current "northeaster" is a slow mover.
- Hurricane Joaquin continues to show the most likely path going out to sea but should continue to be monitored.
