### **ACCOMMODATIONS POLICY – STORM RELATED**

As a general policy, many accommodations adhere to the following guidelines regarding cancellations and refunds, etc.; however, cancellation/refund policies are determined at each individual owner’s discretion.

1. Under **WATCH CONDITIONS** – No refunds provided
2. Under **WARNING CONDITIONS** – Guests can transfer booking to another date.
3. Under **EVACUATION CONDITIONS** – Deposit is refunded and any unused remaining day/night reservation balance is refunded.
